The fund gains a tax advantage if used by a donor who is eligible to claim Gift Aid but does not already have an SEC Gift Aid number. Donors who have a Gift Aid number need not fill in the form on the envelope: their donation will automatically be Gift Aided for the Development Fund unless they write "Not for Gift Aid" on the envelope. Others who are UK taxpayers (other conditions may apply) may fill in the declaration form on the envelope to make a single Gift Aided donation. Name, address and signature are required. All other donations in the special Brown Envelopes will be treated as regular Development Fund donations without Gift Aid.

THE MINI-BUS used for the **Soup Run** now needs replacing especially as it attracts the ULEZ charge every time it goes into London. The price for a good second-hand vehicle would be in the region of £21,000. The church board have voted £3000 towards this. An additional £1500 has been secured from the SEC; £2000 from ADRA. The TED Mission Board, BUC, ARM and Area 7 have also been approached. Please pray that a suitable vehicle can be found soon.
