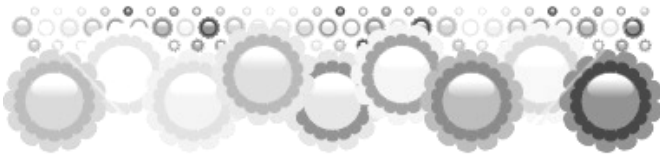
**The Orchestra meets** for rehearsal on Friday at 6.15pm and for the Song Service next Sabbath at 9.30am.
