A Matter of Conscience: Adventist Heroes in World War 1.

In just 9 days' time the world will be remembering the catastrophe that was World War 1. Yet there is a largely untold story of faithful Adventist young men who held both life and the Sabbath to be sacred. Fourteen of them came from Stanborough Park. Next Sabbath, 26 July, we tell that tale, and learn lessons of courage for our own lives.

Open Session and Business Meeting
