An official photographer will be present and has been asked to keep disruption to a minimum.

CONSULTATIVE PLANNING MEETINGS for the church have now taken place and the results are being analysed by the pastoral team presently. IN EARLY 2023 the new budget for the year will be discussed and voted upon shortly thereafter. We are asking all departmental leaders to submit your budgets by 15th December.

PHASE 2 of the church development plan is now underway to improve audio and lighting in the sanctuary. Total cost for this is expected to be in the region of £90,000. Please pray that God will provide the means for this to take place.
