DEVELOPMENT FUND UPDATE

The outstanding SEC Loan at 30 Nov 2022 is £232,249. (The HSBC loan has been fully paid off) The two loans totalled £1,030,212 and £797,963 has been repaid on the loans since then.

CONSULTATIVE PLANNING MEETINGS for the church have now taken place and the results are being analysed by the pastoral team presently. Findings will be presented to the board and a way forward will be planned for these findings. Continue to pray for this process so that we can be more effective in evangelism and nurture.

IN EARLY 2023 the new budget for the year will be discussed and voted upon shortly thereafter. We are asking all departmental leaders to submit your budgets by 15th December.

PHASE 2 of the church development plan is now underway to improve audio and lighting in the sanctuary. Total cost for this is expected to be in the region of £90,000. Please pray that God will provide the means for this to take place.

Pastor Terry will be on annual leave from 23-30 December. Pastor James will take his leave from 25 December to 3 January. Please contact the elders in the absence of the Pastors.
