This year the shoeboxes will be going to Niger, West Africa. Beneficiaries will include orphans and impoverished children.

We suggest school supplies such as pens, pencils and notebooks, and a personal hygiene kit including soap, washcloth, toothbrush and toothpaste. Flip-flops are also a good item to include.

Please do not pack food items or sweets or anything that will melt (ie wax crayons). A small toy may be included, but no battery operated items, please.

Each box should be wrapped and clearly marked whether it is intended for a boy or girl and the appropriate age. Please consider making up generic boxes for either girls or boys as this will help in the distribution.

Boxes should be delivered to the ADRA office by 14th November for shipping to Niger later that week. A donation of £1 for each shoebox you make up will help with shipping costs.
